Position Objective: The role of a Learn to Swim & Water Safety Instructor is to deliver the CA water education program (known as First Splashes) as per policies and procedures. This includes providing a duty of care to learners; and responding to learner or parent/guardian enquiries regarding progress and general information about the First Splashes education pathway.

The major accountability of the role is to maintain comprehensive knowledge of teaching and water safety providing a positive, supportive, and safe learning environment for all swimming and water safety program participants.

Key Responsibilities

Teaching Duties

- Apply lesson plans for each session.
- Deliver classes as per class times and the centre's program.
- Help to set up and pack away teaching equipment for each session
- Complete all administration for each lesson as per procedures
- Assist with an in-house marketing campaigns and strategies that may be employed periodically

Professional Development and Technical Competence

- Take personal responsibility for professional competence by participating in relevant training as required.
- Maintain relevant qualifications
- Take personal responsibility for professional development by participating proactively in all training and coaching sessions as requested.

Professional Expectations

- Maintain a professional approach by adhering to the workplace values and teamwork philosophy of the First Splashes learn to swim program.
- Participate fully in all staff meetings by providing information as requested
- Communicate and interact in a professional manner with customers, parents, children and team members
- Maintain a standard of dress that is in keeping with the industry and expectations of the facility.
- Ensure the safety of all participants at all times
- At all times keep all communal and personal work areas clean and tidy.

General Duties

- Follow all policies and procedures of the CA and the First Splashes learn to swim program.
- Complete other duties as requested.
