Trainee Life Guard / Pool Operations

- To remain informed about current operational issues by attending scheduled meetings, reading relevant memorandums and communication.
- To supervise and control patrons utilising the aquatic facilities and associated equipment
- To monitor the safety of the aquatic areas to ensure a safe environment for all patrons.
- Respond to aquatic area first aid and emergency situations in accordance with Royal Life Saving Society guidelines and Centres policies and procedures.
- Attain the RLSSA Life Guard award qualification
